Pinecone Tricks

What happens to a pinecone in water? Use jars of cool and warm water and found pinecones. Remember to return them to nature when you are finished. Drop your pinecones and prepare to be amazed! Think about why pinecones change in different temperatures. Record your observations and share with a friend!



How Do Animals Stay Warm in the Cold?

Have you ever wondered how animals in cold water habitats stay warm? Try an exhilarating "blubber" and ice water experiment to find out! Use plastic bags, vegetable shortenting, and bowls of ice water to see how insulation keeps animals like California Sea lions, penguins, whales, seals, and polar bears warm in extremely cold temperatures. Can you find any other ways animals stay warm in the winter?
